A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 14-101 OF ZONING ORDINANCE 369, REASIGNING RESPONSIBILITY FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO THE COMPLIANCE OFFICER.

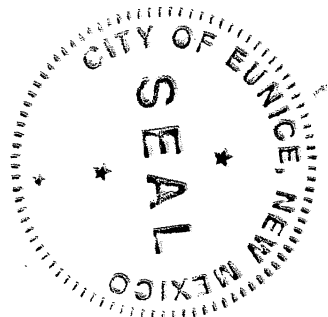
WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Eunice, meeting in regular session this 13th day of July, 2010 did propose this Resolution for adoption, and

WHEREAS, the Resolution relating to zoning duties to be transferred from Public Works to read as;

SECTION 14-101

B. Any owner or occupant who shall fail, refuse or neglect to trim trees and shrubbery as provided in this section, after receiving five (5) days notice from the Compliance Officer to do so, shall be guilty of an offence against the city. Every day that the owner or occupant shall fail, refuse or neglect to trim the trees or shrubbery, after the expiration of the five (5) days notice, shall be a separate offence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EUNICE, NEW MEXICO, does hereby pass, adopt and approve Resolution No. 1096 this 13th day of July, 2010.
